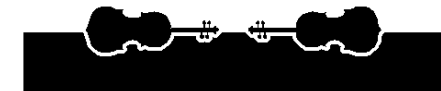

Orchestra and Lessons

Harmonia—A beginning string instrument experience for students entering grades 2-4. Students with no previous experience will have the choice to play violin, viola, cello, or bass. Through weekly group lessons and orchestra rehearsals students learn how to play their instrument with a strong emphasis on individual attention. Tuition includes weekly group lesson and rehearsal, all books and materials, and a minimum of 2 public performances. (Average grades: 2-4)

Preludio—A string orchestra and group lesson program for students at the beginner to intermediate levels (2-3 years of study). This orchestra will focus on the basic fundamentals of ensemble playing and more difficult note reading rhythmically and harmonically. Students may register for rehearsal only, if they are taking other private/group lessons. Tuition includes weekly lesson and rehearsal, all books and materials, and a minimum of 2 public performances. (Average grades: 3-6)

Auditioned Youth Orchestras

Intermezzo—A string orchestra for students at the intermediate levels. This orchestra will focus on advanced ensemble skills and a more challenging repertoire with complex rhythms, varied key signatures and major, minor and modal harmonies. (Average grades 5-8)

Divertimento—A string orchestra for advanced string students. This orchestra will focus on literature selected from standard string orchestra repertoire. (Average grades 8-12)

Concertino—Advanced and committed Divertimento students will be invited to join the Concertino Orchestra. This orchestra will give dedicated students a chance to solo with the orchestra on concertos and will perform standard chamber orchestra literature. (Average grades 10-12)

Audition Information

Auditions are required of all students who wish to be in the Intermezzo, Divertimento or Concertino Orchestras.

Call 952-947-9400 or email michelle@epstringacademy.org to schedule an audition. Auditions will last approximately 5 to 8 minutes.

Playing requirements:

1. One unaccompanied solo piece.
2. One major scale of conductor's choice.
3. Brief sight reading excerpt provided at the audition.

*Your solo should be your most difficult, but polished piece.

Remember, it is not what you play, but how well you play it!

*Students must audition each year regardless of previous participation.

*Previous participation in EPSA does not guarantee placement.

Students will be placed in an orchestra based on their audition.

TUITION INFORMATION

Registration/Audition Fee: \$30.00 for all students (non-refundable, not applicable to tuition.)

Harmonia \$495 Tuition due at 1st class or 2 payments of \$220 due at 1st class and \$300 due the week of January 4th.

Preludio: \$575.00 Tuition due at 1st class or 2 payments of \$300.00 due at first class and week of January 4th

Intermezzo & Divertimento: \$475 Tuition due at 1st rehearsal or 2 payments of \$250.00 due at 1st class and week of January 4th

Concertino: \$100 Tuition in addition to Divertimento tuition

*Tuition includes all books and class material. Students are responsible for providing their own instrument and folding music stand.

*Scholarships—No qualifying student will be turned away because of financial reasons. Please call for an application.

*EPSA offers a sibling discount of \$50 per additional child
